
PREPAID ADVERTISING POSTAL STATIONERY



This next part has to do with the French issue of May 16, 2008 (*Tee Time*, September 2008, page 4). The issue was for the 100th Anniversary of the Golf Club Aix Les Bains. Two members, Dino Tognellini and Stefan, Filanovitch have provided additional information on the stamp.

Dino tried to order the stamp from the postal administration and was told that it was available only to the club and not through the postal system. With this I contacted Stefan to determine more information on its status.

The stamp would be considered as "Printed to Private Order" which means it was printed by the postal administration with limited distribution to the club only and not sold through the post office. A special cancellation for the 100 th Anniversary was available. We would call this cancellation an "unofficial first day cancellation". It does not say "First Day of Issue" as the standard postal issue would have. Also, this issue will not be assigned a catalogue number as most stamps receive.

Thanks to both Dino and Stefan for providing this additional information.
