American Philatelic Society's Stampshow 2009 by Cora Collins

The American Philatelic Society's Stamp Show opened at the David H. Lawrence Convention Center in Pittsburgh, PA on August 6, 2009 and ran for four days. This is the largest US exhibition on an annual basis, only to be superceded by the Internationals hosted by the US every ten years. One of the big attractions is the Champion of Champion Exhibit which is composed of the winning (best in show) exhibits from all the National level shows held between September and July each year. Winners from approximately 30 shows are invited to participate.

In addition to the Champion of Champions Exhibit, an open competition exhibition is available to other exhibitors. My "Sport of Golf" exhibit was in the open competition. Exhibits are judged against standards set for each classification of exhibits. Mine was entered in the thematic category. It received a gold in open competition, the best thematic exhibit of the show and a first place topical award. If you are into exhibiting, you might want to check out the APS shows or annual events. If you want to look for material to further your collection, this is by far the largest show annually and has the most dealers, most of which are from the States, however, there are usually two or three from overseas as well.

There were two members of IPGS who are also members of the Wilkinsburg Stamp Club both in attendance and volunteering at the show, Jim Senkewitz and Thomas Reiff. Jim is the current president of the Wilkinsburg Stamp Club. In addition to the club table, Jim also volunteered at the APS registration booth a for several hours during the show. Jim also provided the following photos of the show. Two of the photos are overviews from above to give you a sense of the vastness of the area covered by the show. The third is a photo (left to right) Tom Reiff, Cora Collins, and Jim Senkewitz, the three IPGS members in attendance.



One evening during the show, Jim invited us to his house to see his "golf museum" which usurps the basement of their house. If it is related to golf-books, newspapers, figurines, glassware, tees, balls, score cards, towels, shirts, etc.--Jim collects it. In addition to the stamp clubs, he is a member of a postcard club and the Golf Collectors Society. Jim mentioned that he plays golf in traditional garb with hickories, however he never said how well he actually plays. I should have asked his handicap.

The stories of how Jim obtained some of the material was very entertaining and we laughed a lot!
