

The frame is in an ornate " Ye Queen's Head" frame, the address is to one side of a dashing mailcoach, and shows two ladies and gentleman playing golf with a caddie looking on & "With Seasons Greetings". The words "Book Post" are printed above the stamp, because the 2d. rate was only available for printed matter (which this card is) at this date. An exceptionally early Picture Postcard.

# SIR WALTER SCOTT GOLFER

Their is no doubt that Sir Walter Scott was a golfer. As through his writings he has caused to mention the language of Golf from time to time. In Redgauntlet he mentions Links and Bunkers.

The fact appears be be sufficiently established by his letter to John Cundell, the Editor of 'Some Historical Notices Relative to the Progress of Golfin Scotland', which was included in the little volume of the 'Rules of the Thistle Golf Club', published in Fdinburgh in 1824, in which Scott declares himself to be 'Still an admirer of that manly exercise, which in former days I occasionally practised'.

1905 Photographic Postcard by J. Patrick of St. Andrews showing members of the Thistle Golf Team who were runners up in the 'Evening Dispatch' Trophy Tournament. Early postcards of this type are especially nice if the people shown are named and what the event was.

The Thistle Golf Club was founded in 1817 and they played over the St. Andrew's Links.







# GOLF POSTAL STATIONERY

1978 POLAND - 1Zt. Postal Stationery Card showing items manufactured in Poland - one being an electrical 'Golf Kart'.



Switzerland first produced a postal stationery card as far back as 1925 showing Luzern Golf Course and since that four others have been issued, the last being 1963.

All cards are printed on a light-buff card with the vingette and stamp printed in color.

In recent years all the cards have become quite elusive in both unused and used state, but now and again they turn up in dealer's counter boxes so it pays to keep one's eyes open.


