
TEE TIME (1989) was entered in the Literature Class at 'LONDON 90'. I am pleased to announce that it won a 'Bronze Medal'.

GOLF SLOGAN POSTMARKS of the UNITED KINGDOM Part 2


Two postmarks were used as advance publicity for the ALCAN GOLF CHAMPIONSHIPS held at St. ANDREWS in October 1967. I will deal with the first of these postmarks in this article - 'ALCAN GOLF CHAMPIONSHIPS £60,000 October 2-8 St. ANDREWS' - and deal with the second postmark in the next issue of TEE TIME.

The dates of use of the postmark is a bit confusing in that they did not all commence on the same day, but, one factor is all of them ceased use on August 1, 1967 - the second publicity slogan commencing on August 2.

The change over of the slogan from CUPAR to DUNDEE is also some -what confusing. Briefly, it was announced that the slogans for the ALCAN were to be used at St. Andrews, Dundee and Carnoustie.

The sponsors (ALCAN) were informed that the Dundee Machine - 'A' was being used with another publicity slogan, - the 'B' machine only dealt with mail in the late afternoon/evening - the sponsors thought that they would not get value by using the 'B' machine, so the slogan was substituted to ARBROATH and CUPAR. So why the change from CUPAR to DUNDEE ('B')? The postmaster at CUPAR had in fact circulated those people who had sent for slogan that he was also going to be using the second slogan. The people who had sent to Dundee were told that the first slogan would not be used. It looks asif there was an Administrative mix-up and boils down to both the first slogan at CUPAR and DUNDEF being quite scarce!

The slogan used at St. ANDREWS was used up until May 18 when it became very worn (See Illustration), a new Town Die was cut and came into use the following day - May 19.



19th Century Colored Court Sized Postcard used from St. Andrews to Blairs, Aberdeenshire in 1902.







THE TELEGRAM FORMS of INDIA

In the 1920's, India which was part of the British Empire issued a number of Telegram Forms featuring advertising. It is not unusual during this time period to see Telegram Forms with advertising, as other Postal Administrations such as - France, Portugal and Italy also issued them. Many of the advertisements are quite interesting and offer us a reflection of life at the time.

Telegram Forms are now being very much appreciated by Topical collectors, particularly exhibitors, as they cover a wide range of topics and were officially issued by Postal Administrations. three forms which we are covering in this article are of especial interest to Golfon Stamp collectors as they feature advertisements for Golf Balls.

The first Telegram Form we are showing (Illustration No.1) features an Ad on the right side for Galirub Golf Balls. All the Telegram forms we have seen, were postmarked in 1924. At the bottom of the front of the Telegram, are three pieces of information that are of special interest to us. First a date (5/11/23) which is probably the date of printing. The second figure (60,000 Bks) is probably the quantity printed. The third figure (S-2) stands for Serie No.2, a numbering system commonly used throughout the World for 'Multi' advertising Telegram Forms or Postal Stationery.

Illustrations No. 2 and 3 feature two Telegram Forms with advertis -ing for Truflite Golf Balls. The only difference between the two forms being the location of the Ad and some other Ads on the form. The second Telegram Form seems to have been issued on September 5, 1925 in quantities of 40,000 and is Serie No. 5. The third Telegram Form was issued on December 5, 1925 in quantities of - 60,000 and is Serie No. 6. For the second Telegram Form, we saw cancellation dates ranging from 1926 to 1928. For the third Telegram Form, we saw cancellations also ranging from 1926 to 1928.

Most of these Telegram Forms are in a very poor condition; either torn or eaten by insects or rusted. A Telegram Form should be considered in good condition if it has only minor faults such as small tears, few spots, folding or small archive holes.


Because these forms were of no interest to Philatelists of the 1920's reasonable to believe that only a small portion of those issued still exist. From our experience, it seems that the oldest one (Serie 2) is the scarcest one. Also considering that many exist in very poor condition, it is our estimate that probably less than 1% of these forms printed still exist in reasonable condition making these Tele -gram Forms not only attractive but quite scarce.


