# WELSH LOVE SPOONS

The age old tradition of the Welsh peasantry to give their loved ones a carved wooden spoon goes back many Centuries. There is evidence to suggest that the giving of a carved spoon by a lover to his lass was regarded as a prelude to courtship - it was given as a sign that a - liason was desired. The carver of the spoon the 'Spooners' - would use the handle as a vehicle to tell of his love by means of symbols. Among traditional carved symbols, the following are a few examples:

HEART - My heart is yours  
VINE - Love grows  
FLOWERS - Affection

CHAIN - Together for ever  
KNOT - Together for ever  
DAFFODIL - Affection and symbol for Wales

In addition to courtship, love spoons are also made for other social occasions such as weddings and christenings. Each spoon is made individually and, consequently, can tell its own story.

The author is the co-ordinator of a student-teacher exchange programme between his own college in Wales and the Southeast Missouri State University (SEMO) and the State University of New York (SUNY). During the summer of - 1989, students of these two Universities commissioned the wood sculptor Edwin Williams to carve a love spoon and indicating that 'Golf' had to be one of the symbols. Unbeknown to the students, Edwin also knew of the author's interest in philately! The illustration shows the completed spoon (12 inches in length) with a link of chain; knot; the completed spoon (12 inches in length) with a link of chain; knot; two hearts joined - Wales and U.S.A; Golfer on a 15c. stamp; SEMO and SUNY united by a bow; Daffodils; a second bow and heart shaped bowl.



# POSTCARD CORNER

In Scotland James VI and I, had learned the game on the historic North Inch (anglice 'Island') of Perth. He appointed William Mayne, 'Bower bruges of Edinburgh', to be the Royal Clubmaker 'during all the dayes of his lyif tyme'.

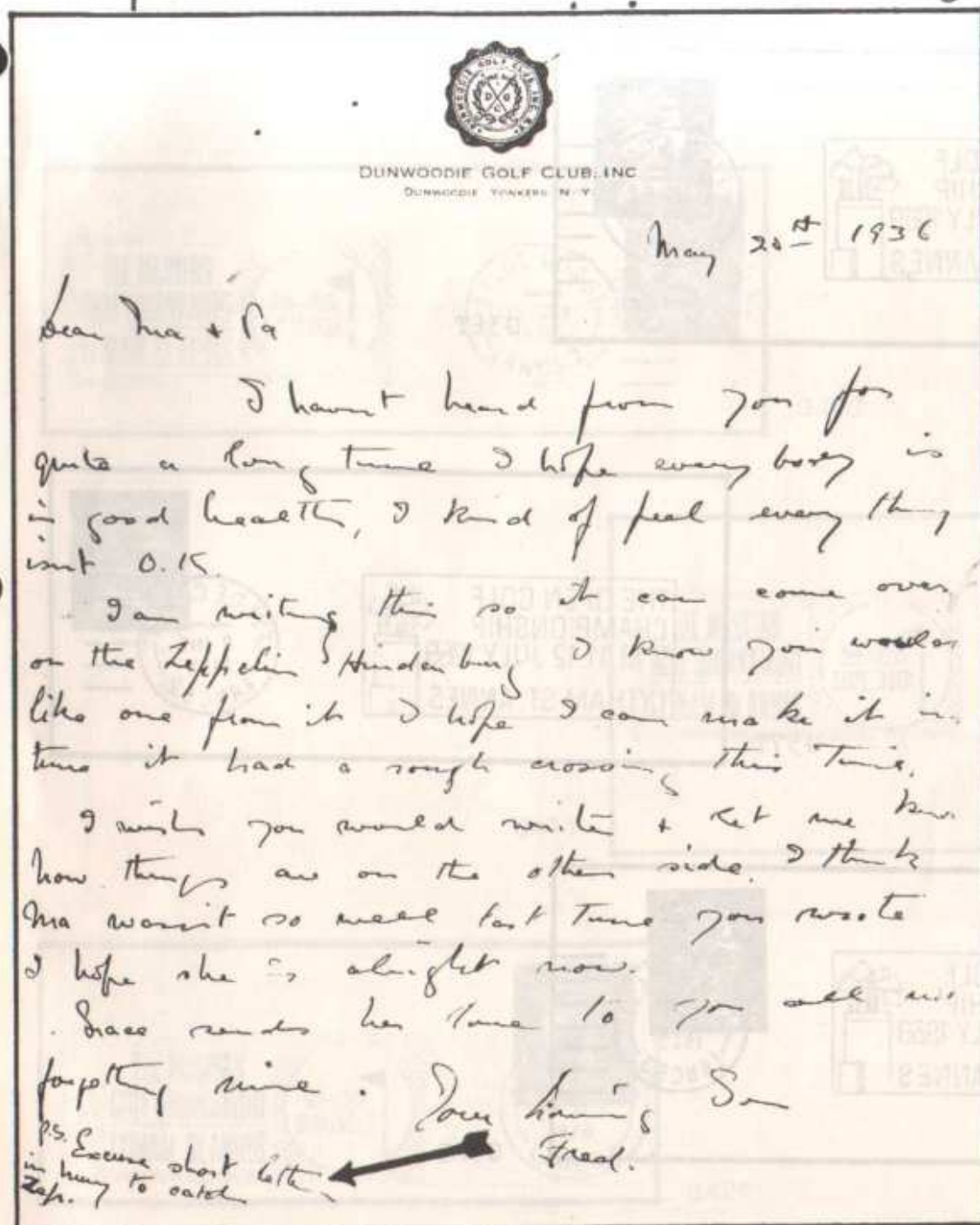
This spoon is unique and a treasured possession and will always be a reminder of far more than the story to be told by symbolism - it is also a reminder of so many students and so many pleasant memories.

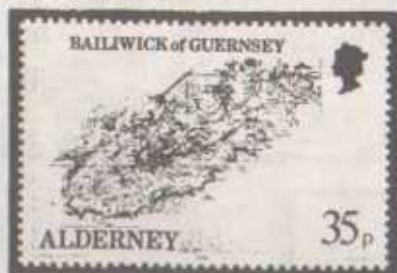




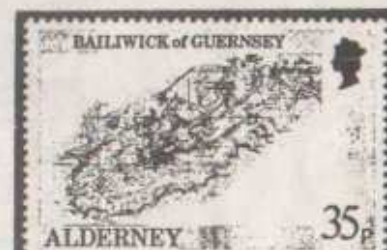

showing 'Course location'

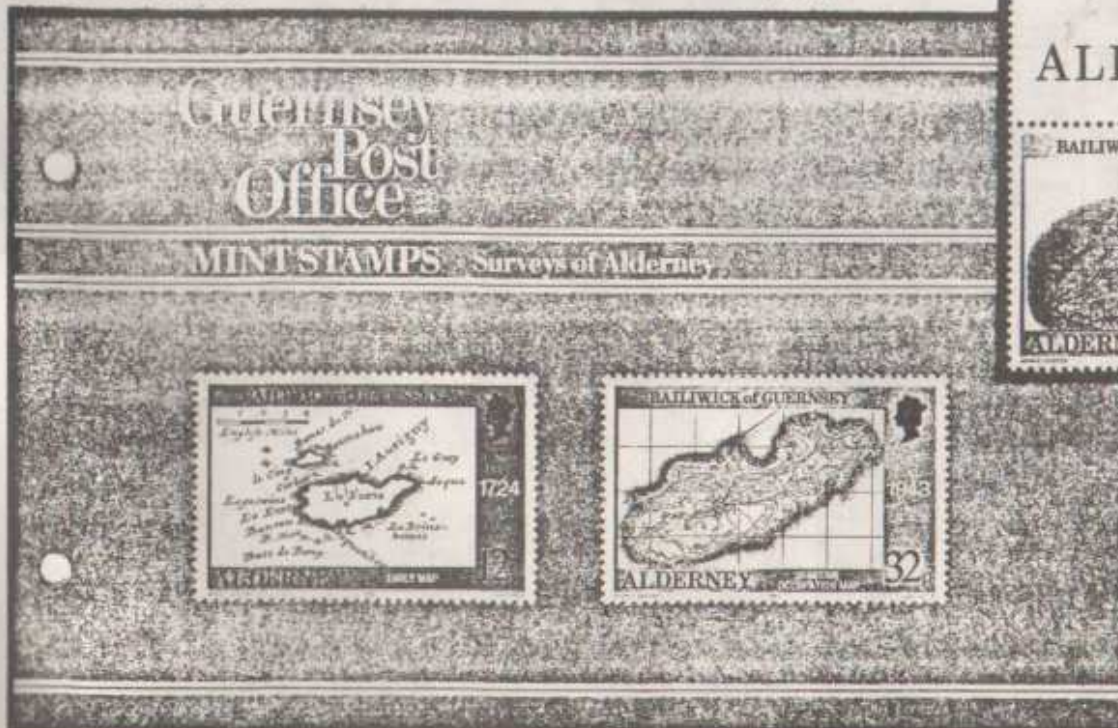
