The World Match Play Championship was first sponsored in 1964 by Piccadilly up until 1976. During 1977 and 1978 it was sponsored by Colgate and from then by Suntory.

In 1974 the first postmark to advertise the Championship appeared as a publicity slogan and was used in the transposed position between - September 16th and October 6th. It was used at Hounslow on the 16th September only, and at Kingston upon Thames and Weybridge.

Hale Irwin, U.S.A. won the Championship by beating Gary Player, South Africa in the Final by 3 and 1.





POSTCARD CORNER


The collecting of modern postcards has become very popular and one has only to look at Postcard Magazines and even Philatelic Journals to see articles covering many subjects.






