So please, be thoughtful and save me this extra time so I can concentrate on printing and distributing the directory.

A UNIQUE ST. VINCENT COVER

Between them they have won sixty-eight major championships: United States Open, British Open, Masters, PGA, United States Amateur and British Amateur. - Jack Nicklaus 20, Bobby Jones 13, Ben Hogan 12, Gary Player 9, Nick Faldo 5, Seve Ballesteros 5, Greg Norman 2 and Jose Marie Olazabal 2. Their careers span eighty years with Bobby Jones winning his first tournament in 1923 and Jose Marie Olazabal winning the Masters a couple of months ago.

They have won on six Continents. The golf souvenir sheet First Day Cover from St.Vincent shown above, Scott No 1560a, was issued November 21, 1991. The sheet pictures eight famous golfers, each on a \$1.00 stamp (This is not as high - valued as it seems, because the total face value of this sheet is about \$6.50 in US currency. The First Day Cover is valued at \$12.00 : with the signatures it's uncalculable!)

This cover circled the globe more than once in an effort to get the seven living golfers to sign it. Only eleven copies exist. Gary Player, Greg Norman, Jack Nicklaus and Nick Faldo each have one. -Private collectors the other seven. It took over a years correspondence with Alistair Johnston to get all the signatures. Not surprisingly, Ben Hogan was the most difficult - it took two tries for it:

THE ROYAL MAIL GOLF STAMPS ISSUE

On July 5, 1994, The Royal Mail will issue a set of five Golf Stamps to commemorate the 250th Anniversary of the Oldest Golf Club in the World, The Honourable Company of Edinburgh Golfers. The set will comprise five stamps depicting the five modern venues of the Open Championship-Royal Troon, Carnoustie, Turnberry, Old Course St. Andrews and Muirfield.

The values will be - 19p St. Andrews, 25p Muirfield, 30p Carnoustie 35p Royal Troon and 41p Turnberry.

The Post Office will issue a First Day Cover with the logo as shown, a Presentation Pack, five Maxim Cards (which also come used). Examples of the two postmarks available are illustrated.

The cost of the complete unit (excluding Maxim Cards used) is £12 (\$22 overseas including Airmail Post and Packing)

1957 Interesting Air Letter which I acquired recently has been sent from Colwyn Bay, Wales to Glenview, IL. It has been struck with a single line 'MISSENT TO GOLF, ILL' cachet in violet and datestamped with the GOLF ILL. duplex type on the back. It is certainly unusual in that 'Golf' is only a few miles South of Glenview and could have been re-directed? Or maybe Golf received too many letters addressed for Glenview!

The letter is from an old-time stamp dealer enquiring about a shipment of Japanese Occupation stamp forgeries.
