It was used on covers sold at the Royal Mail stand at the British Open Golf Tournament. A cachet was applied to covers sold or presented at the stand. 
### WORLD AMATEUR TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP

The WORLD AMATEUR TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP was a major event and France has been elected to host 50 countries and more 80 men or ladies teams, for september 28th to October 9th. For this occasion the FRENCH GOLF FEDERATION has asked me to draw a philatelic program, in order to inform and leave a mark of this event: 22 cancellations and two philatelic documents had been created.

FLAMMES "LA POSTE": These meters were used to oblitarate mail in four post-offices, from July 9th, to October 8th. (A) (B) (C) (D)



METERS: 15 different moulds were created to private franking machines: the French Golf Federation (E), Regional Leagues (F) (G) (H) (I) (J), some partners and sponsors (K) (L) (M) (N) (O) (P) (Q) and the two golf-courses where the Championship was played: Golf National (6734 yards, par 72) and La Boulie-Racing Club de France (6563 yards, par 71). These golf-courses are situated near Paris (R) (S). For these franking machines, it's impossible to specify dates of use.



### SPECIAL HAND-CANCELS :

Three special cancels were produced and used during the Championship:

- at the GOLF NATIONAL (situated at Guyancourt, near Paris)

. Mobil Post Office and special letterbox: september 28th, 29th, 30th, October 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th; little size cancel (diameter 27mm), text: "MONDIAL DE GOLF AMATEUR - GUYANCOURT" (T).
-Philatelic Day: October 1st. Illustrated hand-cancel (diameter 32 mm) (U).

-at the RACING CLUB DE FRANCE-LA BOULIE (situated near Versailles), special letterbox collected on the 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th of October. Little size cancel (diameter 27mm). Text: "MONDIAL

DE GOLF AMATEUR - 78 VERSAILLES" (V). 1







### EDITIONS ISSUED :

French Golf Federation and I, had suggested a stamp's dumy to the Ministry of Posts: for unknown grounds this project fail...However French Golf Federation has printed:

- a POST CARD : design stamp draft. Printing 1. 000 exemplars (W).
- a PHILATELIC DOCUMENT with cover: watercolour (by Hubert Chesneau, the National Golf Course's architect), with three stamps (Golf, Armory of Paris, Ile de France Blazon), franked with the special illustrated cancel (X). Edition of 600 copies, numbered 001 to 600, and selled from 50 FF.

### **CANADIAN GOLF ISSUE**

Recently Canada Post announced that it would issue a set of five stamps to commemorate the Centennial Year of the Royal Canadian Golf Association ( RCGA ).

Featured on the issue are five of the oldest and more renowned Canadian golf courses. These include The Royal Montreal Golf Club at Lle-Bizard, Quebec, located just outside Montreal; Riverside Country Club in Moncton, New Brunswick, the second oldest golf club in The Maritimes; Victoria Golf Club, the oldest golf club on Canada's west coast; Banff Springs Golf Club, a world famous course designed by Stanley Thompson, the great Canadian architect, and Glen Abbey Golf Club, the permanent home of The Bell Canadian Open as well as the site of the Golf House and headquarters of The RCGA.

The RCGA is the governing body of golf in Canada and represents 1400 member clubs. Canada Post based thier descision after much consultation with various bodies and associations. The stamps went on sale on June 6, 1995, 100 years to the day after the first meeting of The RCGA ( then called The Canadian Golf Association ) back on June 6, 1895.

All of the stamps feature a rendering of the course, a silhoutte of a famous person associated with the course, and an inset showing the clubhouse for the particlar course.

The Royal Montreal Golf Club was established in 1873 in Quebec. This is stated to be the oldest club in North America. Previous to the now permanent site of The Canadian Open this site has fielded many a Canadian Open. The founding member was Alexander Dennistoun,

the so-called father of golf in Canada. His silhouette can be found in the lower right hand corner of the stamp.

The second golf course featured in the series is from the adjacent province of Ontario - Glen Abbey Golf Club. It was

established in 1977 near Toronto, and is the site of every Canadian Open since 1977, except one. George Knudson, silhouetted on the stamp, probably one of Canada's finest male golfers frequented this club on a regular basis. Moving a bit





further east to the coast is The Riverside Country Club, in Moncton, New Brunswick, which established in 1897. An original member of Riverside WAS Mabel Thompson, who Canada's first great woman golfer, is silhouetted on the

stamp. Moving directly to the other side of the continent is The Victoria Golf Club in Victoria, British Columbia. This is

the oldest golf club on Canada's western coast, and was founded by Harvey Coombe in 1893. His silhouette is on the lower right hand corner of the stamp. Lastly is The Banff Springs Golf Club which was established in 1927. This course was designed



by Stanley Thompson, who is a member of The Canadian



Golf Hall Of Fame, and silhouetted on the stamp. The course continues to attract international attention due to it's setting in The Canadian Rocky Mountains. Quite often wildlife can be seen on the course, and the ranger frequently warns golfers

not to go looking in the woods for stray golf balls, as there are frequent black bear sightings!

### THE WALKER CUP - 1995

This year's event will be played at Royal Porthcawl G.C. in Wales on September 9 and 10. Illustrated below is the official cover design and special handcancel to be used.
