


Not only do we need a new editor, we also need individuals who are willing to write articles for the journal. This is the members' journal and if it is to continue, others need to contribute some time and effort.

Cancellation Still Available—The following handstamp special cancellation will be available until December 24, 1996, 30 days after usage. One should prepare covers or postal cards with first class postage. The sender also needs to send a SASE with proper return postage.

Prepare your covers and send them to: B.R.S.C. Station, Box 9998, Elyria, OH 44035-9998. November 23-24. The cancellation includes a number of sports such as football, baseball, basketball, soccer, golf, and bowling in a stamplike frame for the 25th Anniversary of the Elyria Sports Hall of Fame, 1971-1996. It's seldom happens that we have this type of information when an issue of *TEE TIME* is due to be distributed. Hope you are successful in getting the cancellations.

# POSTAGE DUE BILL by Cora B. Collins

The item illustrated below is most likely a unique piece of golf philately. First of all, the Babe Zaharis stamp, issued on September 22, 1981 at the first class rate of 18 cents had a short existence as first class postage. By early November the first class rate had increased to 20 cents. Also, since postage due stamps were no longer being issued, the use of postage due bills were also being phased out. During the last few months of use, postal workers could apply commemorative stamps of their choice to make up the postage needed. The bills were used for multiple items going to one address. The letters would be bundled together with the postage due bill on top indicating the amount of postage. While this item was used at a local post office in my area, it came to me through a friend in another part of the state.

#### CANCEL CORNER

There are six new cancels and one update on a cancellation previously reported.

The update involves The First of America Classic cancel shown on page 8, September 1996, TEE TIME. Three cancels are shown for the tournament. The use of all three cancels have been recorded for two days and it is surmised that all three were in use August 5 through August 11, 1996, 7 days. The cancellations have also been found to exist in two colors of ink. Hence, there may be as many as 42 if all combinations are collected—7 days times 3 cancels times 2 colors of ink!!

Other cancellations not previously reported include: U.S. Women's Amateur Station, August 5 through August 10, 1996, Lincoln, Nebraska.





### **NEW ISSUES**

Luis E. Garcia

Ascension Island, located midway between Africa and South America in the south Atlantic, issued a set of stamps featuring Santa Claus on September 23, 1996. The 20p value shows Santa with a golf club over his shoulder and a bag of clubs in his sleigh. See figure 1.

Niger, a republic in northern Africa directly north of Nigeria, featured golf on both a souvenir sheet (figure 2) and a stamp (figure 3). Both items are available perforated and imperforate. The individual stamp was printed in sheetlets of 9 (figure 4).




