Two other members were present at the show, but I did not have the opportunity to meet them. These were Miguel Gil Garcia and Maire Kiddle.



Postmaster installation station, Clute, Texas-July 1 through July 31, 1998, one cancel for each date available in black ink.


Futures Station, Schenectady, New York--July 17, 1998, one cancel in black ink.

Northville Long Island Classic Station, Jericho, New York-August 17, 1998, one cancel in black ink.

Betsy King Classic, Players Station, Limekiln, Pennsylvania—September 21, 1998, one cancel in black ink.

Graebner Chapter Celebrates the 1930s, Summerfest '98 Station, Arlington, Virginia— September 26, 1998, once cancel in black ink featuring Bobby Jones.







In ordering the special cancellation for Clute, Texas, we talked to Mr. Edward K. Adams who provided information about the golf cancel.

Mr. Adams is quite a golfer and he decided to celebrate his installation as postmaster with a special cancel depicting a golfer hitting a ball. The cancel commemorates no golfing event but provided a fun way to celebrate a noteworthy event in his life. This cancel was used for 31 consecutive days.


### **NEW ISSUES**

On September 9, 1997, **Indonesia** issued two sheets of stamps and a booklet for the 19th Sea Games held in Jakarta. A mascot playing golf is depicted in the border of each sheet as well as on the back cover of the booklet.

Ascension issued a sports series containing four stamps on August 17, 1998. A golfer is portrayed on the 35p stamp.





As part of its Celebrate the Century Stamp program, the United States issued a series for the 1930s in August 1998. Bobby Jones is featured on one of the stamps. Unfortunately, stamps are sold only in the 1930s sheet and are not available individually.
