OLYMPHILEX 2000

We returned from our trip down under with a great desire to return and see more of that beautiful land. OLYMPHILEX, as an international show, left much to be desired. The best part of the show was that there were four golf exhibits. Unfortunately, due to the small exhibition area in Sydney, the two promotion class exhibits were housed at the Royal Mint in Canberra and it was not convenient to travel the three hours between the two sites of OLYMPHILEX.

The Centrepoint Tower in downtown Sydney was the primary location for OLYMPHILEX. It was convenient to the harbor area of Sydney, however the exhibition was housed on three floors of the convention center, one of which was a balcony overlooking the second floor. The rows of exhibit frames were extremely close and the only access to the third level was stairs. With the addition of coins and memorabilia, the space was inadequate and hence fewer frames than Atlanta.

The golf exhibits received the following awards: Cora B. Collins, "The Sport of Golf", large vermeil; Patricia Loehr, "The World of Golf", silver; Graham Winters, "Golf", vermeil; and Wayne Pratsch, "Playin Around", silver bronze. In addition, TEE TIME received a bronze in the literature competition. Other members of IPGS exhibiting at OLYMPHILEX 2000 included: Valeriano Genovese, "The Fascinating World of Tennis", small gold; and Dino Tognellini, "Baseball", certificate of participation.

FRONT POSTCARD

The postcard on the front of this issue is an artist signed card published by the Regent Publishing Co. of London. The artist was Kit Forres and the card is identified as No. 623. This card is postally used with a postmark of June 10, 1933. It was mailed from Richmond, Surrey to Lilliput, Dorset, both within England.

Airmail Cover for Royal Air Force by Godfrey Fearn

As he was mounting an exhibit of the 75th Anniversary of the Royal Air Force, he noticed a reference on this cover to a flypast over St. Andrews Golf Course to mark the opening of the new Practice Centre. Unfortunately, the date cancel is not clear, however we know it was mailed in Barbados and it was 1993. This would be a nice items for those of you who have collected other flight covers related to golf, i.e., the CAMs produced in the US during the 1930s.

Turn-of-the-Century Golf Advertising Cover by Patricia Loehr


Harper and Brothers used the same design for their business envelopes from circa 1860 until 1903. Although the envelope design did not change during those years, the list and price of publications did. This cover is an orange color and offers their *Golf* publication at \$2.00 per year. The year of 1900 is a bit light with a crease through it, but the rest of the cancellation is quite clear. There is a receiver mark on the reverse side of October 25, 1900.

The book, The First One Hundred Years of Golf in America by George Peper and The Editors of Golf Magazine published in 1988 mentions Golf magazine on page 157.

"The first, [American golf magazine] titled simply Golf, began in 1897.


"The magazine became the official publication of the USGA, the Western golf Association, and other sectional golf associations."

I wrote to the United States Golf Association to inquire if they could provide any information regarding the information contained in this book. The reply I received was a brief hand-written note stating that *Golf Journal* is the publication of the USGA and it began in 1948. That information is easily found on the content page of each *Golf Journal*. It left me wondering if there ever was indeed, a connection between the commercial *Golf* magazine that is listed on my advertising cover and the not-for-profit organizations. I did not pursue it any further and decided to accept the ambiguity. If there are any members who could provide information about the assertion included in the book, I would be most grateful.



Members of the USGA receive Golf Journal as a benefit of membership. A modern advertising cover promoting membership in the organization pictures a golfer in silhouette having just completed a stroke. Another person, possibly a caddie or another player, is standing nearby.

This cover was sent by paid permit and did not have any bar coding along the bottom. Unlike my turn-of-the -century advertising cover which was 100 years old in 2000, this modern cover will not be possible to date for future philatelists, yet I feel it is an attractive example of a modern advertising cover.

Merit Club Station, 55th US Women's Open, Libertyville, Illinois, July 17 through July 23, 2000, one cancel for each day in black ink.

Curtis Strange Station, Weyerhaeuser Shrine Classic, New Bern, North Carolina, September 11, 2000, one cancel in black ink.

One note, the Merit Club Station had an official cachet featuring one of the golf holes. The post-master at Libertyville, IL 60048-9998 may have a supply of the covers on hand for those who wish to obtain one.

Commemorative Coin by Godfrey Fearn





Another item provided by Godfrey Fearn relates to a Commemorative coin produced by the Royal Canadian Mint. Golf is one of the sports honored in the CANADIAN SPORTS FIRSTS--2000 50 CENT STER-LING SILVER COINS. The composition of the coins is 92.5% sterling silver and the finish is listed as proof. They are priced at \$19.95 each and may be ordered directly from the Mint. The telephone number for the mint is: 1-800-267-1871 or fax 1-613-993-4092. Anyone interested in the coins should call the free telephone number to get further details. However, it is noted on the order blank that they will accept credit cards. This may be a real first-golf on a coin!!! According to Mr. Fearn, the coin shows the Canadian Open of 1904.
