CURT TEICH SAMPLE POSTCARD

This postcard is in the collection of the Curt Teich Postcard Archives at the Lake County Discovery Museum in Wauconda, Illinois. The Curt Teich Company of Chicago saved an example of each postcard it produced during its years of operation --1898-1978. This particular advertisement card for golf shoes was produced in 1937 which can be determined from the number in the lower right hand corner.



Reverse or address side of card

The reverse (see previous page) or address side of the postcard is setup to advertise the shoes. The store need only fill in a price and their retail place of business.

The card is exceptionally colorful, and since it is in the archives, in pristine condition. Last April I had the opportunity to see the card and several other golf postcards during a visit to the museum and the separate archives building with a couple of philatelist friends.

IPGS Meter Stamp Handbook

Several members have contributed information for the handbook and I want to thank them for taking the time and effort to be a part of this project. They are Peter Andersen from Denmark, Dino Tognellini from Italy, Allen Payne and Les Stubbington from England, Roger Weik from Australia, Dr. Eiron Morgan from Wales, and Joan Bleakley and Luis Garcia from the United States.

This has become truly an international effort and illustrates the global interest in golf philately. Peter, Dino and Les made the extra effort to send

color photocopies of their meters. If you do not send color copies, please include information about the color of your meters. Even though most meters are red, other colors have been used. Although most of the meters listed are single listings, some meter "groups" have appeared and I have included a page of some of them. Both Peter and Roger supplied several examples of the early Australian Slazenger meters. This company seems to have changed their meter design frequently. Do you have any others to add or any additional years for those that are already listed?

Dr. Eiron Morgan and Les Stubbington added additional information to the North British Company meter group. Les sent in another design to add to those illustrated in the previous update. These seem to be the earliest Great Britain meters. Are there any more years, designs, or locations to add?

So far the earliest meters listed for the United States are the group of Walter Hagen meters. Are there any additional designs for this company, or years? Are there any earlier US meters other than the Hagen meters?

Meters for "Shell's Wonderful World of Golf" seem to be quite plentiful as you can see from the list, however the meter that included NBC in the text seems to be an exception. Most of these meters were generated in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Joan Bleakley sent along the Norco, Louisiana location. If you have any Shell meters in your collection, please check to see if you have any new information to add.

Finally, (for now) these is the Kemper group of meters I mentioned in the previous update. Dr. Eiron Morgan sent in a new design from 1973. Check over the meters you have and decide if you want to participate in the handbook. The more we know about the golf meter stamps the better we will be able to appreciate them as a very exciting and interesting element of golf philately.

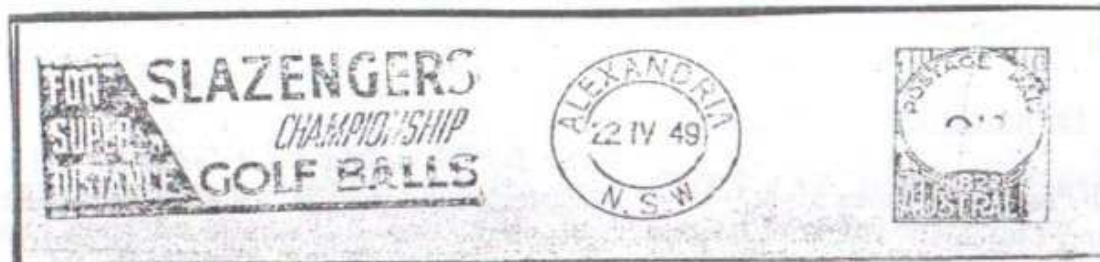

Prior to the beginning of the show Yutaka Matsubayashi contacted all IPGS members from Japan inviting them to meet at PHILANIPPON. Thanks to his efforts we were able to have an enjoyable get together and talk about our favorite philatelic subject--golf philately.

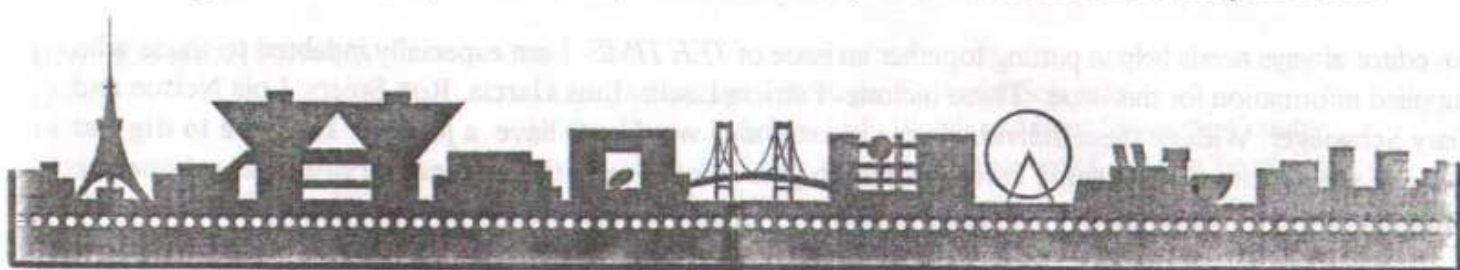
PHILANIPPON '01 is the third international philatelic exhibition to be held in Japan. The first was called PHILATOKYO '81 held on Harumi (an island in Tokyo Bay), the second was PHILANIPPON '91, also held on Harumi, and PHILANIPPON '01 was held at the Tokyo International Trade Fair Commission, Ariake. This location has been nicknamed "Tokyo Big Sight". Both Harumi and Ariake are man-made islands or reclaimed land in Tokyo Bay.

The exhibition consisted of 3,000 frames of exhibits and approximately 100 dealers and postal agencies. The show theme was: A celebration of Stamps - dreams from across the globe. It was held during the first week in August (August 1 to 7) to encourage Japanese school children to visit the show.

We met at the show about 10 a.m., spent a couple of hours viewing color photocopies of "The Sport of Golf" an exhibit by Collins. Then due to space limitations three of us had a personalized picture printed on the tabs of the stamp issue for PHILANIPPON '01 and then we enjoyed lunch together. It was a great pleasure to meet three of our members from Japan and spend time together talking about golf philately.

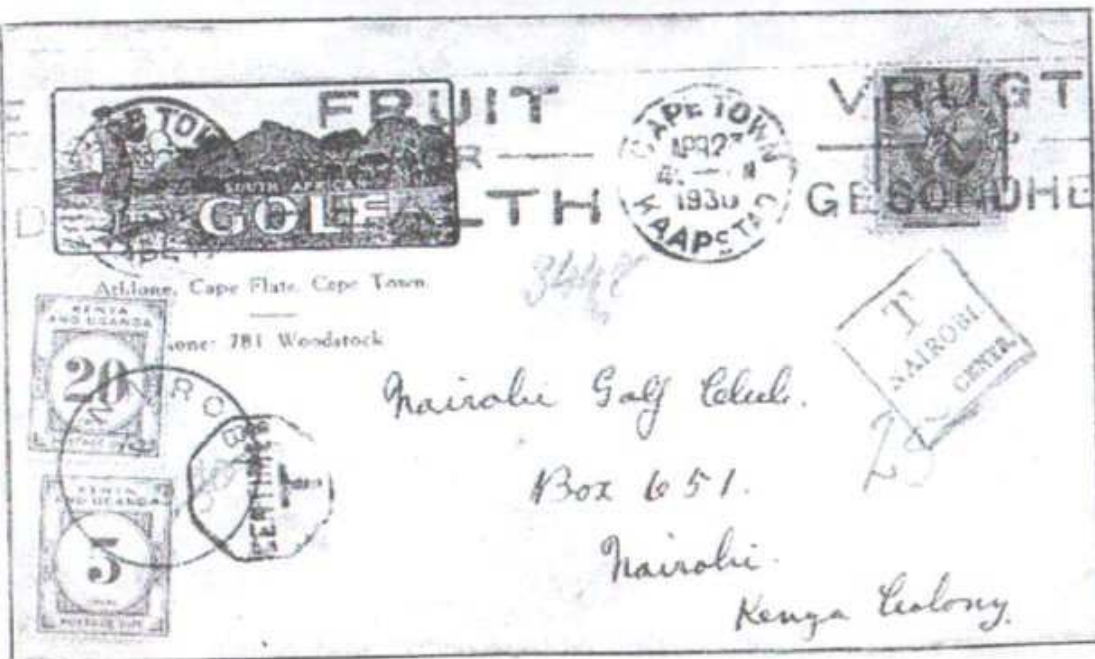

Advertising envelope for golf holidays at Cape Flats, Capetown, bearing (SG30) ½d green and black tied by Capetown slogan cancel "Fruit for

Health" addressed to Kenya but underpaid. Left octagonal box indicates 30 centimes are due, in local currency 25 cents. On arrival, Kenya and Uganda postage dues (SG D1) 5 cents purple and (SGD3) 20 cents green are applied and tied by Nairobi receiver cancel.



To me this is an attractive and colorful example of a golf cover which has correct commercial usage and interesting detail. It tells a good "story" of the postal history of South Africa and is made more attractive by the golf element--Eiron.

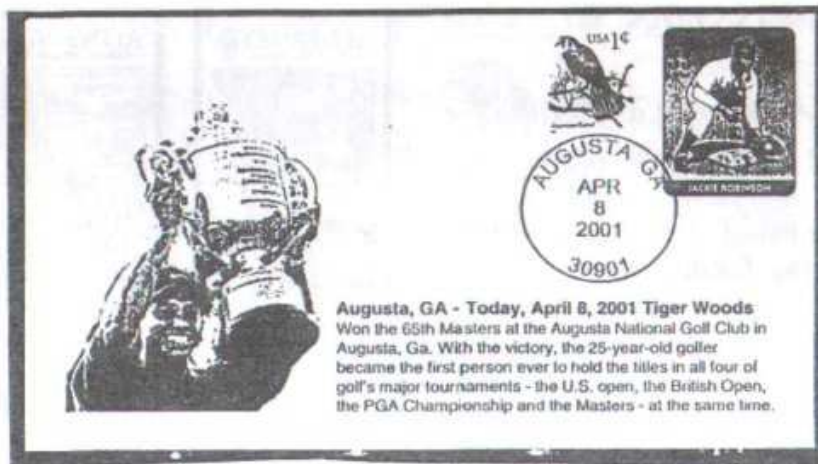

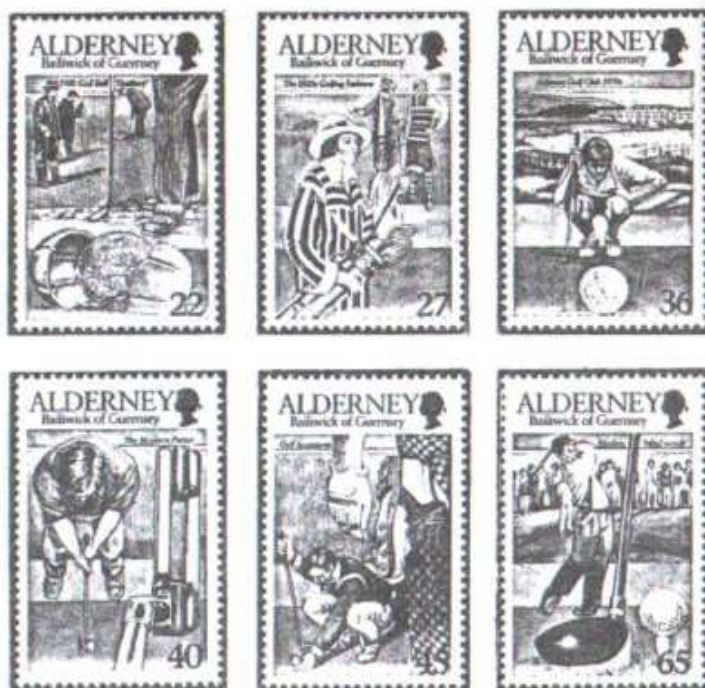
Past-Times Alderney Golf Club Equipment through the Ages

In this, the third in Past-Times series issued by Alderney, golf is the featured sport and the Alderney Golf Club's course is pictured. The club was formed in 1970 just as the course was completed. It is a nine-hole/18 tees affair set against a backdrop of sky and sea, with some of the island's Victorian fortifications and other landmarks in the near distance while the coast of France is visible just a few miles away.

Each summer the club hosts the Alderney Open, which attracts golfers from other Channel Islands, and the United Kingdom. It is also on the itinerary of the Channel Islands Alliance, a group of islands' golf professionals and assistants who meet at various venues to hone their skills and compare notes.

Before 1970 Alderney was anything but a golfer's paradise, as there had been no course of any description since the early 1930s. What had kept the faithful few entertained in the early part of the century was a crude collection of three holes between Fort Albert and Saye Farm. This was the brainchild of one Alf Baker, a member of 2nd Battalion Middlesex Regiment, which was stationed in Alderney in 1908. A keen golfer, Mr. Baker had brought with him a couple of clubs and a few balls, and spent his spare time doing what a frustrated golfer with a little initiative would do: we'll call that a hole, tee off from over there and have a bit of fun. While few officers joined in nothing official was made of it and by the late 1920s the course was overgrown and eventually abandoned.

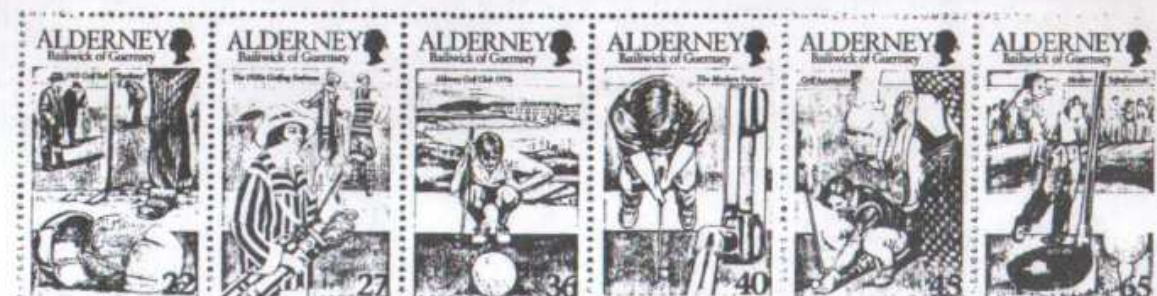
As golf constantly changes regarding advances in equipment, the stamps chart some of those developments. The set begins with a 22p stamp



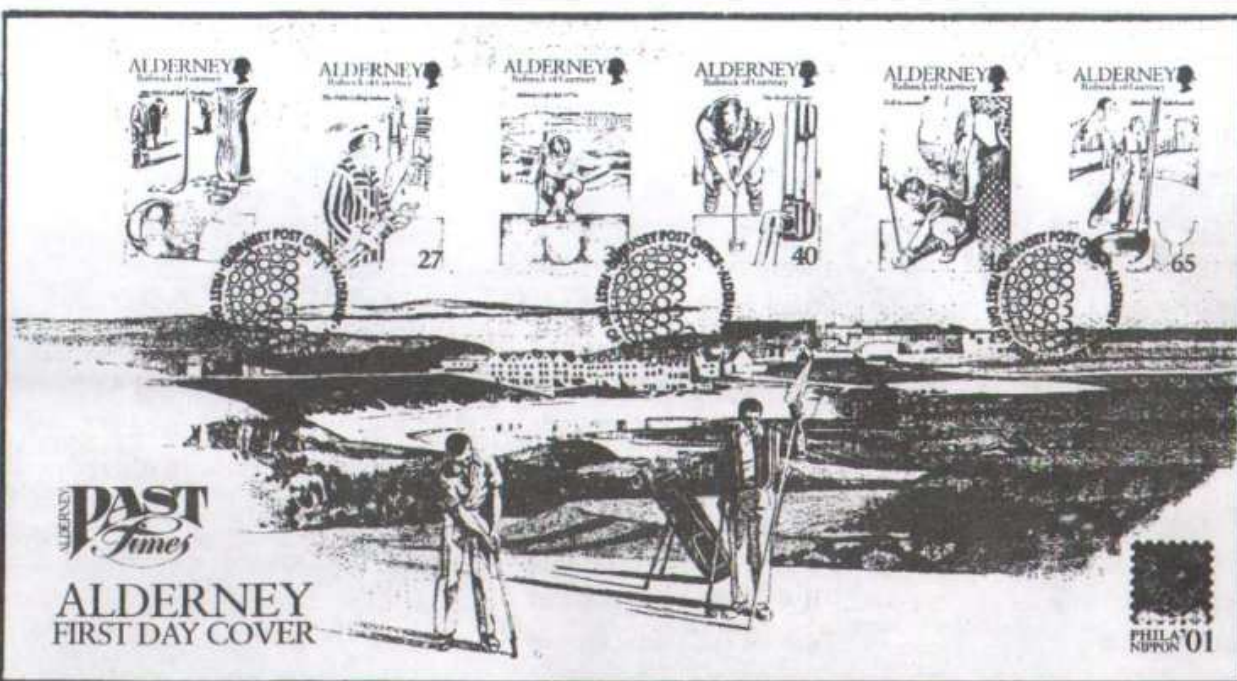
features a "feathery" golf ball of 1901. Note the absence of golf attire, with the players wearing their normal daytime clothes and shoes. The 27p shows golfing fashions of the 1920s, when women were fashionably dressed and men wore plus-fours. A more modern ball appears on the 36p value, a study in concentration from the 1970s as a shorts-wearing woman lines up a putt with Braye Beach in the background. From there we move to a contemporary putter on the 40p with a birds-eye view of a golfer and his view of the putter's head. On the 45p we can see the gloves and spiked shoes which are worn today. The final, 65p, shows a modern "lofted wood".

The same designs appear on a souvenir sheet. Colleen Corlett was the designer of the stamps and they were printed by the House of Questa by an offset lithography method.

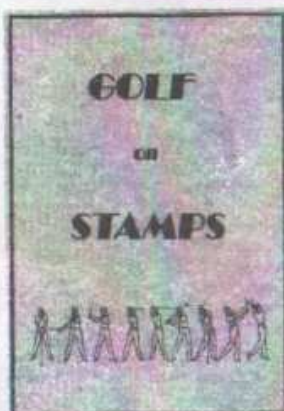
