

Front Postcard

This is one of two Pinehurst Country Club picture post cards which have the 1916-1917 Golf Tournament Schedule on the reverse side. The card shown begins with the Midwinter Tournament December 28-30 and January 1-2. This one was mailed in December of 1916 to W J Glidden of the Glidden Varnish Co., in Cleveland, OH. The second card, not shown, begins with the St. Valentine's Tournament January 30-31, February 1-3. This card was also mailed to WJ Glidden. Interestingly enough the cards were both mailed from Boston.

The tournament schedule called for 9 tournaments during this part of the year. Note that the tournaments had all existed for a number of years-i.e., two were the seventeenth annual and the least was a seventh annual.

It would be interesting to know if the Pinehurst Country Club published similar tournament schedules for other years and other months of the year.

DENMARK GOLF MUSEUM CELEBRATES COLLECTION OF BORGE VENGE

On October 6, 2004, the Denmark Golf Museum held a ceremony to honor IPGS member, Borge Venge for his generous donation of golf stamps and other golf memorabilia.

Venge, a retired press photographer, resides in Ebeltoft, Denmark. His vast collection numbers more than 10,000 stamps, covers, cancellations, postacards, phonecards, cigarette cards, bag tags, ball markers and other golf related items. Also included are autographed photos of professional golfers Jack Nicklaus, Seve Ballesteros, Bernhard Langer and Thomas Bjorn, all of whom Venge had photographed during this career.

Museum Chairman, Erik Halling, a friend of Venge's, had visited him during the summer and was impressed to see much of the collection on display in his home. When Venge told Halling he would like to donate the collection to the museum, Halling said that he was so excited that he could not sleep that night. The museum, located at the Munkebjerg Hotel in Vejle, has dedicated a special room to display Venge's initial contribution of hundreds of items. The remainder of his collection has been bequeathed to the organization.



Venge began playing golf in 1976, when his late wife encouraged him to take up the game as a means of relaxation from the long hours and travel demands of his job. He instantly took a liking to the sport. Combined with his love for photography, he developed a special interest in golf stamps and philatelic items which he considers a form of art. At 85 years young, he is still an avid collector and golfer, although his recuperation from leg surgery kept him off the links for the 2004 season.

IPGS salutes Borge Venge for his love of our hobby and his generous gesture to highlight it to golf lovers and visitors to Denmark for many years to come.






Japanese Scenic Cancels Yutaka Matsubayashi





Spain

Luis Garcia and Yutaka Matsubayashi provided the Spanish souvenir sheet. The sheet contains three stamps and three labels. The golf design is shown on the upper right hand stamp 1,90 Euro value and the label just below it also features golf. This sheet was issued on May 27, 2004.



Dominica

Luis Garcia also provided a stamp from Dominica which is one of eight stamps issued for the 2004 Olympics with an Olympic history theme. Each of the athletes depicted represents different sports from many Olympics since the beginning of the modern games in 1896.

The date of issue for the Dominica stamp is unknown at present. If you can supply any information on the issue date, please let us know.



Australia

Roger Weik provided a souvenir sheet issued by the Australian Post to celebrate the Centenary of the Australian Open Championship being held at the Australian Golf Club. It was first staged in 1904 and returned to the same club where it all started to celebrate 100 years. The Open is Australia's national golf championship and, apart from the four global Majors, is a tournament that all Australian professional golfers want to win.

The list of former champions reads like a who's who of the world golf. It includes: Gary Player, seven times; Jack Nicklaus, six times; Peter Thompson, three times; plus Gene Sarazen, Arnold Palmer, Tom Watson, and Greg Norman.

The Australian Open was held 25-28 November, 2004. A copy of the souvenir sheet is shown on the next page.
